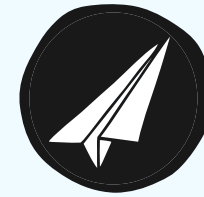

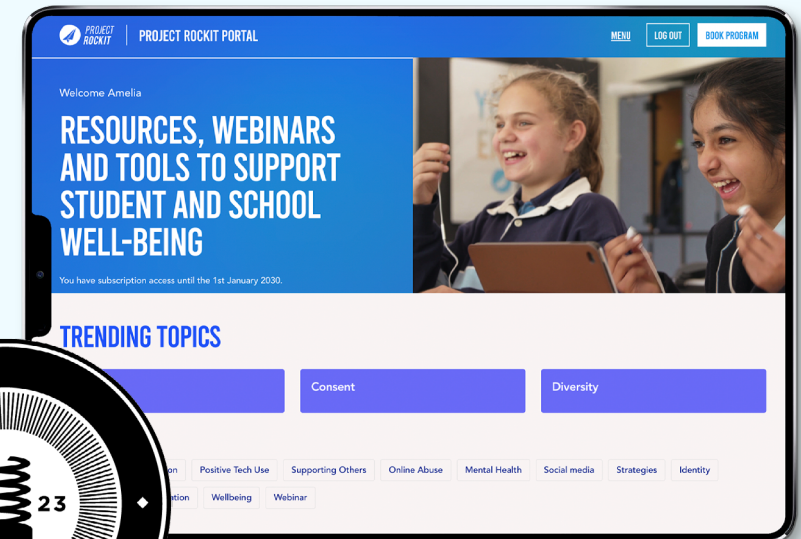

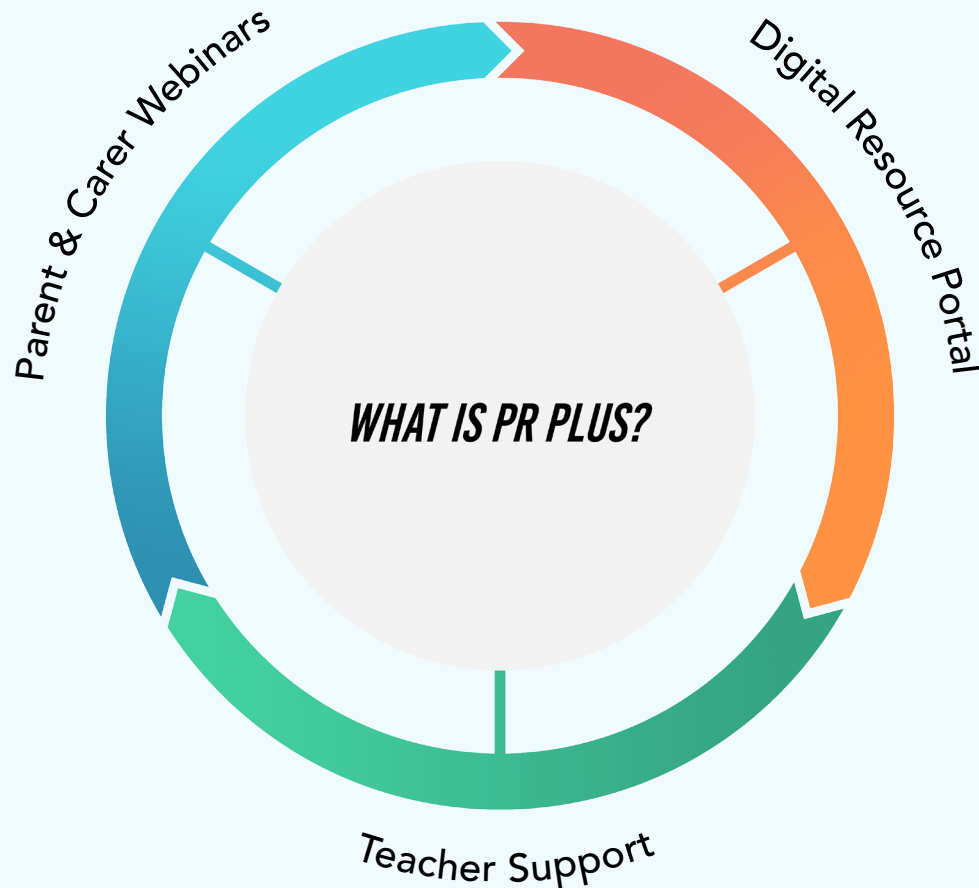

CURRICULUM STATEMENT
